Here's an update on what the Lord is doing in Burkina Faso through the ministry of Dr. Moussa Coulibaly and his teams.

Schools

Burkina Faso has the highest illiteracy in the world, so what better way would there be to show the love of Jesus for children and youth than by providing them with the opportunity to receive an education. We are constantly adding to this important part of the ministry. We now have a secondary school for 7th and 8th grade in Ouagadougou, the capital city. We have one more elementary school, so we now have six elementary schools in Bobo, the second largest city in Burkina Faso. We have a total of 1,870 students in our schools. The majority of our students come from non-Christian families, so we thank you for your prayers and support.

This is the home for widows and orphans, primarily but not only for those affected by HIV/AIDS. But it is proving to be a blessing to some homeless teen girls also. Several of our secondary school students were facing very bad home situations. At least one girl was kicked out of her home. The home situation is complicated, but she has decided to follow Christ and her father and stepmother are not Christians. There are five other girls who are in similar situations. So we now have these six young women staying in the Bethesda Home while they attend school. Getting an education will mean that they will have choices and control in their own lives. They will be able to continue following Jesus.



Elim Bible Institute



Here are some of the students excitedly opening boxes with some books to help them in their studies. They will become teachers, pastors, and lay leaders. Donations supply them with their books, plus the needed copies of lessons created by Dr. Moussa. Some of the students would like to become pastors and church planters, but they have no source of income. We are hoping to provide some skill training so they can go out as tent-makers.

Dr. Moussa's son, Timothee, has received a scholarship to pursue his doctorate in economics in Dijon, France. Please pray for him as he has just arrived a month late because of the political turmoil in Burkina Faso. A good understanding of economics will be a blessing to Burkina Faso.
